House Intelligence Committee Releases Report Assessing Intelligence Community Reform

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The Oversight Subcommittee of the House Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence will release a report assessing the implementation of the Intelligence Reform and Terrorism Prevention Act of 2004.

Members of the news media are invited to attend a press conference **tomorrow** at **11:30 a.m. in 2456 Rayburn House Office Building**. Subcommittee Chairman Mac Thornberry (TX-13) and Subcommittee Ranking Member Robert E. (Bud) Cramer, Jr. (AL-05) will discuss the report and take questions.

The Subcommittee on Oversight was created by Intelligence Committee Chairman Pete Hoekstra (MI-02) and Intelligence Committee Ranking Member Jane Harman (CA-36) in the 109th Congress to review strategic intelligence issues. One of the primary tasks assigned to the Subcommittee is overseeing implementation of the Intelligence Reform and Terrorism Prevention Act of 2004.

The Subcommittee report gauges progress in accomplishing the goals of the Act in key areas, such as:

- Leadership of the Intelligence Community
- Improving Analysis
- Information Sharing
- Civil Liberties
- Personnel, Training, Culture and Security Clearances
