## **House Intelligence Committee Requests More Information in CIA Tapes Inquiry**

Washington, D.C. – *Today, Chairman Silvestre Reyes, D-TX, on behalf of the House Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence, sent letters to the Department of Justice, the Office of the Director of National Intelligence, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Department of State, the Department of Defense and the White House seeking information for the House Intelligence Committee’s ongoing inquiry into the destruction of CIA interrogation videotapes.*

“Based on our continuing review of CIA documents related to the destroyed videotapes, we have reason to believe these agencies possess information relevant to our inquiry,” said Chairman Reyes. “When the Committee announced its investigation, we stated that we were determined to follow the facts wherever they may lead, and that we would use every tool at our disposal to conduct a fair and complete review of the facts. That is precisely what we are doing.”
