## **Reyes Announces Intelligence Subcommittee Chairs and Membership for the 111th Congress**

*WASHINGTON (February 12) – Following an organizational meeting of the House Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence, Chairman Silvestre Reyes announced the chairs and Democratic membership of the four intelligence subcommittees for the 111<sup>th</sup> Congress.*

The Subcommittee on Terrorism, Human Intelligence, Analysis, and Counterintelligence will again be chaired by Rep. Mike Thompson of California. The Democratic members of the Subcommittee are: Rep. Alcee L. Hastings; Rep. C.A. “Dutch” Ruppensberger; Rep. Jim Langevin; Rep. Adam Schiff; Rep. Adam Smith; and Rep. Dan Boren.

Rep. C.A. “Dutch” Ruppensberger will return to chair the Subcommittee on Technical and Tactical Intelligence. The Democratic members are: Rep. Rush D. Holt; Rep. Jim Langevin; Rep. Patrick Murphy; Rep. Adam Smith; and Rep. Adam Schiff.

Rep. Anna G. Eshoo will again chair the Subcommittee on Intelligence Community Management. The Democratic members of the Subcommittee are: Rep. Rush D. Holt; Rep. Alcee L. Hastings; Rep. Jan Schakowsky; and Rep. Patrick Murphy.

Rep. Jan Schakowsky will take over the chairmanship of the Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations. The Democratic members of the Subcommittee are: Rep. John F. Tierney, Rep. Patrick Murphy, Rep. C. A. “Dutch” Ruppensberger; Rep. Mike Thompson; Rep. Adam Schiff; and Rep. Dan Boren.

Following the announcement, Reyes added, “I congratulate the new and returning Subcommittee chairs and look forward to working with them and all the members of the Intelligence Committee. Much of the Committee’s oversight responsibilities are conducted at the Subcommittee level, so having such skilled and experienced chairs is critical to fulfill the Committee’s mission.

“I am pleased that Chairwoman Eshoo, Chairman Ruppensberger, and Chairman Thompson are once again lending their expertise to these critical posts. In addition, I welcome Chairwoman Schakowsky to her new leadership role in the Committee, and I am confident her energy and vigilance will be valuable assets to Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations.”
