Chairman Reyes statement on passage of FISA legislation in U.S. House

Washington, D.C. – *Congressman Silvestre Reyes, D-El Paso, Chairman of the House Permanent Select on Intelligence, released the following statement on S. 1927, the Republican legislation on the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act (FISA) considered by the U.S. House of Representatives tonight. Chairman Reyes voted against the bill.*

“H.R. 3356, the Democratic bill on FISA, gave the Director of National Intelligence the tools he asked for to protect our country,” said Reyes. “That was stronger legislation because it protected our country and the U.S. Constitution.

“We will continue our ongoing, in-depth work investigating the FISA system, crafting a legislative fix, and conducting rigorous oversight of the Administration.”
