Subcommittee Hearing on Preventing Violent Radicalization in America

THACI Subcommittee Chair, Sue Myrick, Announces Open Hearing

WASHINGTON, D.C. – U.S. Representative Sue Myrick (NC), Chairwoman of the Subcommittee on Terrorism, HUMINT, Analysis, and Counterintelligence (THACI) today announced a new date for the open THACI subcommittee hearing that had to be postponed last week due to votes. The hearing will now take place on Wednesday, July 27, 2011 at 3:00pm in Rayburn (Room B-318).

The hearing will focus on the Bipartisan Policy Center’s recently released report, “Preventing Violent Radicalization in America”. Dr. Peter Neumann, principal author of the report, will testify as to the findings and recommendations in the report. Dr. John Gannon, a member of the Bipartisan Policy Center’s National Security Preparedness Group, will provide context and analysis of the issue.
