## **Chairman Rogers Supports Term Extension for FBI Director Robert Mueller**

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Chairman of the House Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence, Mike Rogers, today released a statement saying he supports the President’s intention to seek an extension of FBI Director Mueller’s term.

“The President announced today that he intends to seek a two-year extension of FBI Director Mueller’s 10-year term. I am happy to support this extension in light of the leadership changes that are set to occur later this year at CIA and the Department of Defense.

“Director Mueller has overseen the most significant evolution in the history of the FBI, doubling the agent force on national security and tripling the number of analysts, as the Bureau transitions to an intelligence-driven organization. As the FBI works to complete this process, I look forward to continuing to work closely with Director Mueller. The House Intelligence Committee will hold a hearing with Director Mueller on May 25<sup>th</sup>, during which I will be interested to hear the Director’s plans for the FBI through 2013.”
