## **Committee to Hold Open Hearing on FBI's Intelligence Transformation**

*Chairman Rogers Announces Open Hearing  
Followed by Closed Session*

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Chairman Mike Rogers (R-MI) today announced the House Intelligence Committee's second open hearing of the 112<sup>th</sup> Congress. The full Committee will convene in an open hearing to focus on the FBI's transformation into an intelligence driven organization.

FBI Director Robert Mueller will testify before the Committee and provide an assessment of where the FBI is in the process of this transformation, and what still needs to be done to complete it. Additional topics, including the Patriot Act and the FBI's work against terrorist threats to the homeland may also be raised.

The open hearing will be held at 2:00pm on Wednesday, May 25, 2011 in room HVC-210 of the Capitol Building. The closed session will immediately follow in a different room.
