FY11 Intelligence Authorization Bill Signed Into Law

Chairman Rogers Praises Bipartisan Effort

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Chairman Mike Rogers today praised the signing of the FY11 Intelligence Authorization Bill into law. President Obama signed the bill into law Wednesday afternoon.

Chairman Rogers said, “The signing of this bill into law reaffirms to our intelligence professionals on the front lines that we are serious about providing the support they need to keep America safe. This new law not only provides our intelligence agencies with the tools and capabilities they need to do their jobs and protect our national security, but also assures the American people that intelligence activities are funded wisely and conducted in a manner consistent with our values. I am pleased with the bipartisan effort it took to move this bill through Congress, and I am gratified the President signed this bill into law.”
