



## Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Court Overview



- U.S. federal court established under the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act (FISA) of 1978.
- Comprised of 11 District Court Judges appointed by the Chief Justice of the U.S. Supreme Court, each serving one seven year term.
- No judge appointed to the FISC may be appointed more than once.
- Court overseen by the House and Senate Intelligence and Judiciary Committees.
- Located in the E. Barrett Prettyman United States Courthouse in Washington, D.C.
