AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1892

OFFERED BY MR. Schiff

At the appropriate place in the bill, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. ____ . REPORT ON TRAINING STANDARDS OF DEFENSE**

2 **INTELLIGENCE WORKFORCE.**

3 (a) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date
4 of the enactment of this Act, the Director of National In-
5 telligence and the Under Secretary of Defense for Intel-
6 ligence shall submit to the Permanent Select Committee
7 on Intelligence and the Committee on Armed Services of
8 the House of Representatives and the Select Committee
9 on Intelligence and the Committee on Armed Services of
10 the Senate a report on the training standards of the de-
11 fense intelligence workforce. Such report shall include—

12 (1) a description of existing training, education,
13 and professional development standards applied to
14 personnel of defense intelligence components; and

15 (2) an assessment of the ability to implement a
16 certification program for personnel of the defense in-
17 telligence components based on achievement of re-
18 quired training, education, and professional develop-
19 ment standards.

1 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

2 (1) DEFENSE INTELLIGENCE COMPONENTS.—

3 The term “defense intelligence components”
4 means—

5 (A) the National Security Agency;

6 (B) the Defense Intelligence Agency;

7 (C) the National Geospatial-Intelligence
8 Agency;

9 (D) the National Reconnaissance Office;

10 (E) the intelligence elements of the Army,
11 the Navy, the Air Force, and the Marine Corps;
12 and

13 (F) other offices within the Department of
14 Defense for the collection of specialized national
15 intelligence through reconnaissance programs.

16 (2) DEFENSE INTELLIGENCE WORKFORCE.—

17 The term “defense intelligence workforce” means
18 the personnel of the defense intelligence components.
