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MR. AKHMETSHIN: Hillary Clinton through her, I mean, in her house, socially.

MR. CONAWAY: So you're going to Hillary Clinton's house.

MR. AKHMETSHIN: No. Hillary Clinton was a frequent guest in her house.

MR. CONAWAY: Oh, at the colleague. So you were there at a fundraiser? What was the event?

MR. AKHMETSHIN: No, it's just dinners, I think. Some functions, I think birthday parties or something to that effect. I met her a few times. Last time I saw her the funeral of Evelyn Lieberman.

MR. CONAWAY: And so how often have you met with her?

MR. AKHMETSHIN: Four or five times maybe.

MR. CONAWAY: Okay. Do you think she'd recognize you on sight?

MR. AKHMETSHIN: I'd be surprised.

MR. CONAWAY: Did you donate to her campaign?

MR. AKHMETSHIN: Never.

MR. CONAWAY: Well, gentlemen, anything else?

Thank you very much for your patience and your time today. The instruction that [REDACTED] give you at the beginning of the meeting will dictate the process going forward. And we appreciate you being here.

For that, we're adjourned. Thank you.
